Basic Courses Required for All Degrees

Students can complete the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT) to fulfill the 2 year, General Education Program at Western (see next page for worksheet). More information about admission for transfer students can be found at the following web site: http://www.wou.edu/admission/transfer/

Not all students choose to complete a 2 year degree before transferring. You can complete just some of your course load at Chemeketa Community College without getting the AAOT before transferring to Western. BA in Art and Design requires 2 years of a language. BS in Art requires a total of 12 credits of Math and Computer Science including MTH111 *College Algebra* and CIS101 *Introduction to Microcomputer Apps*. BFA in Art usually requires an extra year.

Students can transfer up to 124 credits to Western.

AAOT Worksheet: to transfer with a 2 year degree AND be art major ready

All courses must be passed with a C or better. A minimum of 90 credits is required for the AAOT degree, but since students can transfer up to 124 credits to WOU, take the extra electives below to transfer as a third year art major. WR121The College Essay and MTH 105 Math in Society must be taken in the first two terms. WR122 Argument and Research and COMM111 Public Speaking need to be completed in year one.
